What to expect during the CCPC Virtual Event

We are excited to have you join us for the 2023 CCPC PLAY Academy Professional Development Event. We have over 150 participants, a variety of workshops and an interactive facebook group where you will be able to chat with providers, discuss workshops, and shop! It's going to be a great week of learning.

During our virtual sessions we will be using Zoom, which can be joined via desktop or laptop with a webcam/audio, or on mobile devices like a tablet or smartphone with camera/audio. This training requires you to participate in both video and audio, similar to in-person trainings!

The day before each session you will receive an email with a link to your virtual zoom training and any hand outs the presenter may have.

The day of your session, you will join by clicking the hyperlink in the email, your web browser will open, and take you directly into the Zoom meeting. You may need to click on [open.zoom.us], especially the first time you use Zoom Click "Join with Computer Audio" You will be automatically muted upon entry in the the session.

You will need to have your camera turned on so we can see all of our participants during the entire session. If you are not on camera you will be removed from the session. Be ready to be engaged! We have many opportunities to use the chat box and/or microphone systems, and we love to hear from you.

Please be sure to arrive on time and stay the entire time. Participants attempting to enter the virtual room more than 15 minutes after the scheduled start time will not be allowed into the session. In addition, participants who leave the virtual room

before the scheduled end time will not receive a certificate.

We will be taking attendance using the chat feature of zoom. If you have multiple people watching one screen each participant will need to sign in on the chat. Please do not skip this step - If you do not sign into the chat you will not recieve credit for the class.

Participants will be asked to complete a training evaluation survey for each session. A link will be provided during each session in the chat box.

A CCPC board member will be monitoring the chat box and email. If you need technical assistance, please reach out!

Tips for a Virtual Zoom Session

Before the event downloard Zoom on to your device and make sure everything is working properly to avoid issues during the live session.

We encourage you to log in early (up to 15 minutes before your training begins) to work through any technical problems that may arise.

Find a quiet place where you will be able to concentrate.

Mute yourself unless you are participating in a group discussion or have any questions during the training.

Please be aware of your background during the training.

Remain kind and courteous of other participants!

Respect the virtual training just like you would an in-person training.

According to KDHE your camera needs to be on at all time and you need to be present for the entire session. If your camera is off or you are not visiable to the host you will be sent a message. If you do not reply or continue to be off camera you will be removed from the session and not recieve a certificate for that session.

CCPC is excited to offer participants a place to chat, ask questions, share ideas and even shop!


After each session we will have a post where participants can ask the speaker more questions and engage in further discussion about the session topic.
